



The Chattanooga Community Kitchen (CCK) serves more than 170,000 meals each year to those less fortunate among us.

Supplementing the dry good donations with a source of healthy protein can be a challenge.

But, we have found a source of lean, healthy protein to help meet the dietary needs: *Wild Tennessee Hogs*, lean protein, $\frac{1}{4}$ cholesterol of store bought pork. The yield could be as high as 150lb. /hog.

A local game warden has offered us a harvest of ~45 hogs he is planning to trap.

We have identified a generous USDA processor who will convert that harvest for CCK for \$40/hog. A harvest of that size would net the CCK enough protein for 200 meals.
